

LLOYD VanMETRE

LLOYD VanMETRE, son of William Morton VanMetre (1864-1949) and Mary Luella Lynch (1867-1960), was born on 19 Aug 1894 in Marengo, Crawford County, Indiana.

Lloyd was the Haskell County, Kansas postmaster from 1928 to 1936. He also worked as a carpenter and was a railway mail clerk. He married **ALETHA “HAZEL” STULTZ**, daughter of William Robert Stultz (1874-1958) and Julia Ann Stogsdill (1876-1966), on 18 Jul 1919 in Garden City, Finney County, Kansas. Hazel was born on 27 Jun 1901 in St. John, Stafford County, Kansas.

They had three daughters: **AUDREY LAVERNE (VanMETRE) KOLSKY** (1920-2016), **LETA RUTH (VanMETRE) POTTROFF** (1924-2004), and **VERNA MAE VanMETRE** (1929-1932).

Lloyd died on 24 Apr 1973 in Fort Lyons, Bent County, Colorado and Hazel passed away on 6 Apr 1996 in Liberal Seward County, Kansas. Burial for both was at the Copeland Cemetery in Copeland, Gray County, Kansas
