GRACE (LUDWIG) OLSON, daughter of Ellis D. Ludwig (1858-1935) and Vashti B. Young (1856-1932), was born on 9 Jan 1892 in Sabetha, Nemaha County, Kansas. In the year 1900, the family was living in Berwick, Nemaha County, Kansas. By 1910, they had moved to Waynoka, Woods County, Oklahoma.

In 1920, Grace was living in Haskell Township, Haskell County, Kansas. She was 28 years old at the time. There, she met and married **JOHN OLSON**. They continued to live in Haskell County, making Sublette, Kansas their home. John was born in 1874 in Wisconsin. He passed away in 1930.

In 1940, Grace was working as an Abstractor and Stenographer and on 14 May 1942, the Postal Service appointed Grace as the Sublette, Haskell County Post Master. She was involved in the Methodist Church, Eastern Star, the Rebekah Lodge, and the White Shrine.

John and Grace did not have children.

Grace passed away on 16 Jun 1967 in Sublette and buried at the White Chapel Memorial Gardens in Wichita, Sedgwick County, Kansas.
